Spelling Termly	List of 100 words. Pupils complete a test on these words in September, at Christmas, at Easter and at the end of the year. Spelling Weekly	10 spellings based around a rule that will be taught in school.	Test will be Tuesday and new spellings will be given each Monday	10-15 minutes / week	List sent home each week and available on website.
Reading	10 minutes at least 5 times a week with an adult. When complete, please sign in the Home/ School Diary	Reading records will be checked every Monday morning.	30 minutes / week	
Times Tables	All tables up to 12x12. Pupils complete a test on these times tables in September, at Christmas, at Easter and at the end of the year.
