Kit list

What to bring

Your clothes are likely to suffer wear and tear and also get dirty and wet, therefore you should bring several changes of old clothes for doing activities. Jeans are not suitable for activities as they get heavy and cold when wet and don't dry out quickly. Please ensure that all items are named.

Please DO NOT BRING

Any electronic devices including mobile phones or iPads/iPods or valuables (i.e. jewellery).

Lost Property

Please label everything your child brings. Children are responsible for their own belongings – it may help to provide them with a list of the items you pack. Lost property is hard to track down after a visit and there is a charge for returning any items back to the UK.

Clothing

- Suitable nightwear
- Underwear
- Long and short sleeved T-shirts
- 1 pair of trainers/ shoes suitable for walking
- Trousers/Leggings
- Hat and gloves
- Waterproof jacket/ cagoule
- 1 or 2 sets of clothes for evenings

For Activities

- 1 pair of old trainers (may get muddy/wet)
- Old clothes – long sleeved t-shirts, leggings, sports clothing capacity)
- Fleece/sweatshirts/hoodies
- Waterproof jacket

Other Essentials

- Washbag (incl. soap)
- Towel for showering

- Alarm clock
- Labelled plastic bag (for wet/dirty clothes)
- Small rucksack for days out

- ▶ Packed breakfast and lunch for Monday- no fizzy drinks. £5-10 English money for burger on way home.

If a member of your group has a **specific dietary requirement** or is particularly choosy about what they eat, we will always prepare something suitable. And if they'd like some more to eat, we can offer alternatives and extra food.
- ▶ Can buy sweets and souvenirs when out and about. Maximum of 25Euro, but **do not need this much**. Day group leaders will look after money.
